## 6th August - Hiroshima Day

- \* Hiroshima Day observes the tragic anniversary of the atomic bombing of Hiroshima, Japan by the United States during World War II in 1945.
- ❖ On August 6, 1945 the bomb nicknamed "Little Boy" exploded approximately 600 meters above Hiroshima.
- \* Theme "Together with the Hibakusha, let us achieve a nuclear weapon-free, peaceful, and just world for the future of humankind and our planet".

# Energy Self-Reliance Very Important For Developed India: PM Modi Hails Record Gas Production

### PM Narendra Modi hails record gas production in country

- ❖ Our self-reliance in the field of energy is very important in achieving the goal of 'Viksit Bharat'.
- ❖ The gas production in 2020-21 was 28.7 BCM and increased to 36.43 BCM (Billion cubic meters) in 2023-24.
- ❖ The country is expected to reach 45.3 BCM gas production by FY26, according to Union Petroleum and Natural Gas Minister, Hardeep Singh Puri.

### Government declares Adichunchanagiri in Karnataka and Choolannuar in Kerala as Peacock Sanctuary

- ❖ Union Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change Mr. Bhupender Yadav said that the Central Government has declared Adichunchanagiri in Karnataka and Choolannuar in Kerala as Peacock Sanctuary.
- Several measures are being taken for the conservation of the national bird and the ministry has also set up breeding and conservation centers for peacocks.


### Jharkhand launches Mukhyamantri Maiyaan Samman Yojana for women

- ❖ The Mukhyamantri Maiyaan Samman Yojana was earlier called Jharkhand Behan Beti Swavalamban Protsahan Yojana.
- ❖ It is a direct benefit transfer (DBT) scheme in which eligible women beneficiaries receive Rs. 1000 per month from the state government directly in their bank accounts.
- ❖ Chief Minister Hemant Soren and State Women and Child Development Minister Baby Devi will transfer the first instalment to the beneficiary's account on 16<sup>th</sup> August 2024.
- ❖ Women in the age group of 21-50 years are eligible for the scheme. The beneficiary's annual income shall be less than Rs. 8 lakhs.
- ❖ An estimated 48 lakh women are estimated to be eligible for the scheme. The scheme is expected to cost the state government around Rs. 4000 crore per month.


Government releases set of four commemorative postage stamps to celebrate 33rd Olympics Games going on in Paris

- ❖ These stamps represent sports such as Javelin Throw, Field Hockey, Sailing and Table Tennis.

Double Olympic medallist Manu Bhaker to be India's flag bearer at closing ceremony in Paris

- ❖ Double Olympic medallist in Paris, Manu Bhaker is set to become India's flag-bearer at the Olympics 2024 Closing Ceremony on August 11, according to Indian Olympic Association (IOA).
- ❖ Bhaker scripted history in Paris as she became the **first Indian** to **win two Olympic medals** in a **single edition** and also the **first-ever female Indian shooter** to **win an Olympic medal**.





Novak Djokovic Clinches First Olympic Gold Medal at the Paris 2024 Olympics

- ❖ Novak Djokovic won his first Olympic gold medal by beating Carlos Alcaraz in men's tennis singles final.
- ❖ Djokovic's impressive career already featured a men's-record 24 Grand Slam titles and the most weeks spent at No. 1 in the rankings by any man or woman.
