

12th August – International Youth Day

- In 1965, the UN General Assembly approved the declaration of promoting peace, mutual respect, and understanding between people, amongst the youth.
- The United Nations declared 12th August the International Youth Day in 1999, first celebrated on 2000.
- Theme 'From Clicks to Progress: Youth Digital Pathways for Sustainable Development'.





- ✤ On August 12, 2012, the inaugural World Elephant Day was launched to bring attention to the urgent plight of Asian and African elephants.
- Project Elephant was launched in 1992 by the Government of India. The Indian elephant (Elephas maximus indicus) is classified as "Endangered" on the IUCN Red List.
- ✤ As of 2024, the elephant population in India is around 15,000 individuals throughout Asia.

DBS appoints Tan Su Shan as First Female CEO

- Singapore's DBS Group has appointed Tan Su Shan, currently its institutional banking group head as CEO, replacing Piyush Gupta, who has led Southeast Asia's biggest bank for 14 years.
- She will be the **bank's first female chief executive** and also the first to be appointed from within the ranks of the bank.

Youth of Jammu and Kashmir's **Baramulla district** created a world record by registering their names to the Universal Records Forum (URF) for the largest-ever **Kashmiri** folk dance performed by **10,000** young women at the 'Kashur Riwaaj' cultural festival.

INITIATIVE

India's First Grain ATM Launched in Odisha

- WFP (World Food Programme) and the Government of Odisha launched India's first around the clock grain dispensing machine, the 'Grain ATM' also known as 'Annapurti', in the state capital Bhubaneshwar.
- Odisha has become the first state in India to provide access to the public distribution system beneficiaries 24 hours a day.
- Annapurti is energy efficient and consumes only 0.6 Watts per hour and can be connected to solar panels for automatic refilling.





Chhattisgarh Approves Country's Third Largest Tiger Reserve

- The Guru Ghasidas Tamor Pingla Tiger Reserve, which integrates an existing national park with a wildlife sanctuary, is Chhattisgarh's fourth reserve for the big cats.
- It spans 2,829 square kilometers across four northern districts of the state (Manendragarh - Chirmiri -Bharatpur, Koriya, Surajpur and Balrampur).
