IITGN, IIT Indore join hands to set up cNARMADA to assess river ecosystem

- Indian Institute of Technology Gandhinagar (IITGN) has set up the Centre for Narmada River Basin Management (cNARMADA) at its campus to conduct the Condition Assessment and Management Plan (CAMP) of the Narmada river basin.
- ✤ IITGN has joined hands with Indian Institute of Technology Indore (IITI) for the assessment undertaken by the Ministry of Jal shakti.
- ✤ It will also prepare a road map for comprehensive rejuvenation and conservation of the riverine ecosystems.

AGREEMENT

India and Maldives renew MoU for training 1,000 Civil Service Officers

- ✤ India and the Maldives have renewed their Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to bolster the training of Maldivian civil servants.
- The renewed MoU spanning from 2024 to 2029, will facilitate the training of an additional 1,000 civil service officers from the Maldives.

SCHEME & INITIATIVE

Union Cabinet approves PMAY - U 2.0 scheme; One crore houses to be built for urban poor & middle-class families

Financial assistance will be provided to one crore urban poor and middle-class families through states and Union Territories to construct, purchase, or rent a house at an affordable cost in urban areas in five years.

✤ The government will provide Rs. 2.30 trillion in assistance under the scheme.

PMAY - U Overview

- It launched in 2015. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY - U) aims to provide all weather 'pucca' houses to eligible candidates in urban areas.
- PMAY U 2.0 targets families from economically weaker sections (EWS), low income group (LIG) and middle income group (MIG) who do not own a pucca house anywhere in India.



Eligibility Criteria

- **EWS Households**: Families with an annual income up to **Rs. 3 lakh**.
- LIG Households: Families with an annual income from Rs. 3 lakh to Rs. 6 lakh.
- > MIG Households: Families with an annual income from Rs. 6 lakh to Rs. 9 lakh.

Interest Subsidy Scheme

- Beneficiaries taking loans up to Rs. 25 lakh for houses valued up to Rs. 35 lakh will receive a 4% interest subsidy on the first Rs. 8 lakh loan for up to 12 years.
- Eligible beneficiaries can receive a maximum subsidy of Rs. 1.80 lakh in 5 yearly installments.



Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs gives nod to eight railway projects worth 24,657 crore rupees

- The total estimated cost of the projects is Rs.
 24,657 crore.
- These projects will save 767 crore kg of CO₂, which is equivalent to planting 30 crore trees.
- Aspirational districts and tribal areas will get a major push of development through these projects.

Paris Olympics 2024 concluded: India finished at 71st spot

- India with a total of 6 medals, including one silver and five bronze medals, finished at the 71st spot in the overall medal tally.
- The 2028 Summer Olympics Los Angeles. It's the 3rd time LA has hosted the games, following 1932 and 1984.
- Baseball and softball will be making their Olympic return. New sports - flag football, cricket, lacrosse and squash.
