#### NPCI Spins Off BHIM into a Separate Arm; Lalitha Nataraj appointed CEO

- ❖ The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) incorporated Bharat Interface for Money (BHIM) as a wholly-owned subsidiary, into a new entity known as NPCI - BHIM Services Ltd (NBSL).
- ❖ Former banker Lalitha Nataraj will head the new subsidiary as its chief executive officer (CEO).

# CABINET DECISION 9\*\* AUGUST, 2024 Amendment in Pradhan Mantri JI-VAN Yojana

- Modified scheme extends timeline for implementation of scheme by 5 year i.e. till 2028–29
- Financial support to Advanced Biofuel Projects using lignocellulosic biomass and other renewable feedstock

#### Benefits:

- Will provide remunerative income to farmers for their agriculture residue
- Will contribute to India's energy security and self-reliance



#### **SCHEME**

Cabinet extends PM Ji-Van Yojana implementation by 5 years, to infuse further funds

- ❖ Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday approved extension of modified Pradhan Mantri JI-VAN (Jaiv Indhan- Vatavaran Anukool fasal awashesh Nivaran) Yojana for another five years ie., till 2028-29.
- ❖ The cabinet also approved further investment of Rs. 1,969 crore into the programme.
- The scheme aims to provide remunerative income to farmers for their agriculture residue, address environmental pollution, create local employment opportunities and contribute to India's energy security and self-reliance.

#### Pradhan Mantri JI-VAN (Jaiv Indhan - Vatavaran Anukool fasal awashesh Nivaran) Yojana

- ➤ It was notified in March 2019.
- Financial Outlay: Rs. 1969.50 crore for the period 2018-19 to 2023-24.
- Financial Assistance: Rs. 150 crore per project for commercial projects and Rs. 15 crore per project for demonstration projects.
- Nodal Ministry: Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas
- ➤ Biofuels are renewable fuels derived from organic sources, such as plants, agricultural and forest residues, algae, and animal waste.
- ➤ Under the scheme, the first 2G Ethanol Project set up by Indian Oil Corporation Limited at Panipat, Haryana has been dedicated to the nation by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2022.
- The other 2G commercial projects being set up by BPCL, HPCL and NRL at Bargarh (Odisha), Bathinda (Punjab) and Numaligarh (Assam) respectively are also nearing completion.

#### **SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY**

TRAI mandates all Service Providers to immediately stop promotional calls from unregistered telemarketers to curb increasing spam calls

In a major step to **curb the increasing number of spam calls**, regulator Telecom Regulatory Authority of India **(TRAI)** has mandated all service providers to **stop voice promotional calls**, be pre - recorded or computer generated or otherwise, from all unregistered senders or telemarketers.



### DRDO successfully carries out maiden test flight of Long Range Glide Bomb GAURAV from Sukhoi-30 MK-I



- ❖ The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) on successfully carried out the maiden flight test of the long-range glide bomb (LRGB) Gaurav from a Su-30 MK-I fighter jet of the Indian Air Force.
- ❖ The test was conducted off the coast of **Odisha**.
- ❖ Gaurav is an air-launched 1,000 kg class glide bomb capable of hitting targets at long distances. The LRGB has been designed and developed indigenously by the Research Centre Imarat, Hyderabad.
- ❖ Complete flight data during the test launch was captured by Telemetry and Electro optical tracking systems deployed by Integrated Test Range along the coastline".

#### North India's largest floating solar project commissioned in Omkareshwar

- ❖ Madhya Pradesh has commissioned the largest floating solar project in central and north India, generating 90 MW at Omkareshwar.
- **❖ Omkareshwar Floating Solar Project** is located at Omkareshwar in District **Khandwa**, **Madhya Pradesh**.
- ❖ The floating power plant was developed on the backwaters of Omkareshwar dam (it is a gravity dam on the Narmada River).
- Project Cost is 646 crores.

### 10<sup>th</sup> bilateral Mitra Shakti Military Exercise Commences in Sri Lanka

- ❖ The annual bilateral Mitra Shakti military exercise between the Indian Army and the Sri Lankan Army commenced in the Sri Lankan Army Training School, Maduru Oya in Sri Lanka's Southern Province.
- Scheduled from 12 to 25<sup>th</sup> August, is an annual Combined Training Exercise of the two countries' Forces.
