India hosted the 3rd Voice of Global South Summit virtually




- India hosted the 3rd Voice of Global South Summit on 17th August virtually under the theme "An Empowered Global South for a Sustainable Future".
- Discussions on a range of complex challenges that continue to affect the world, such as conflicts, food and energy security crises and climate change.
- 3rd Summit was held in a virtual format and was structured into Leaders' Session and Ministerial sessions.
- 123 countries joined Voice of Global South summit; China, Pakistan not invited.
- 21 countries whose heads of state and government attended the summit are Bangladesh, Belarus, Bhutan, Chile, El Salvador, Ethiopia, Fiji, Grenada, Guyana, Lao PDR, Marshall Islands, Mauritius, Mongolia, Nepal, Oman, Sri Lanka, Suriname, Tajikistan, Timor Leste, Uruguay and Vietnam.
- ✤ Prime Minister Narendra Modi chaired the Leaders' session at the summit.

CCPA Imposes Rs 3 Lakh Fine on Sriram's IAS for Misleading Claims Over UPSC 2022 Exam Result

- The Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) has imposed a penalty of Rs. 3 lakh on Sriram's IAS for advertising misleading claims regarding the result of UPSC Civil Service Exam 2022 : the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution.
- ✤ Instead of the 200 selections as claimed by the institute, there were only 171 selected candidates.
- Out of these 171 candidates, 102 were from Free Interview Guidance Programme (IGP), 55 were from Free Test Series.
