APPOINTMENTS

SC constitutes committee headed by former HC judge Justice Nawab Singh for grievant farmers

- ❖ The Supreme Court constituted a committee headed by former Punjab and Haryana High Court judge Justice Nawab Singh to amicably resolve the grievances of protesting farmers at the Shambhu border between the States of Punjab and Haryana.
- ❖ The committee is to convene its first meeting within a week.
- ❖ A bench comprising Justices Surya Kant and Ujjal Bhuyan passed the order in a petition filed by the State of Haryana against an order of the Punjab and Haryana High Court to remove the blockade at the Shambhu border (which was erected by Haryana to prevent the protesters from marching to Delhi).

SCHEME & INITIATIVE

1st foreign university in India under UGC

- ❖ The Centre granted permission to the UK-based University of **Southampton** to establish a **campus** in **Gurugram**, **Delhi NCR**.
- ❖ The University of Southampton will become the first international university to set up a campus in India under the UGC (Setting up and Operation of Campuses of Foreign Higher Educational Institutions in India) Regulations, 2023 notified in November last year.

❖ The regulations, which allow top 500 foreign universities to set up campuses in India, were prepared in line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

Cabinet approves seven major schemes for improving farmers' lives and livelihoods with total outlay of Rs. 14,235 crore Crore

- ❖ Digital Agriculture Mission: The initiative will employ tools such as artificial intelligence (AI), big data, and geospatial technologies to revolutionise agricultural practices. The Mission has a total outlay of Rs. 2,817 crores.
- **Crop science for food and nutritional security:** with a total outlay of **Rs. 3,979 crore**.
- **❖ Strengthening Agricultural Education, Management and Social Sciences**: with a total outlay of Rs. 2,291 Crore
- ❖ Sustainable livestock health and production: with a total outlay of Rs. 1,702 crore, the decision aims to Increase farmers income from livestock and dairy.
- ❖ Sustainable development of Horticulture: with a total outlay of Rs. 1129 crore the measure is aimed at increasing farmers' income from horticulture plants.
- ❖ Strengthening of Krishi Vigyan Kendra: outlay of Rs. 1,202 crore, these centers play a crucial role in disseminating knowledge and best practices to farmers across the country.
- ❖ Natural Resource Management: with an outlay of Rs. 1,115 Crore focused on the sustainable management of natural resources.

UP Govt to Build Vedic-3D Museum in Varanasi



- ❖ Uttar Pradesh government will construct a Vedic-3D museum in PM Modi's parliamentary constituency Varanasi at the main building of the Sampurnanand Sanskrit University.
- ❖ The state of the art museum will be dedicated to Indian astrology, astronomy and Vedic literature.
- ❖ The museum will showcase the evolution of Vedic literature as well as contributions of Indian sages and serve as a platform to revive the tradition of 'Shastrartha' (spiritual discourse).

IIM Lucknow establishes Centre of Excellence in Blockchain Technology

- ❖ In partnership with Microsoft India, IIM Lucknow will establish three outreach centers across Uttar Pradesh to promote and nurture blockchain based innovation.
- ❖ The proposed regions for these centers are Gorakhpur, Lucknow and Greater Noida/Meerut.

Union Minister for Science and Technology Dr. Jitendra Singh released the Biotechnology for Economy, Environment, and Employment (BioE3) Policy 2024

- ❖ BioE3 policy will prove to be a milestone not only for the bio economy but a game changer for Viksit Bharat @2047.
- ❖ The policy is aimed at 'Fostering High Performance Biomanufacturing' aligned with National initiatives of the government of India such as 'Net Zero' carbon economy and Mission LiFE (Lifestyle for environment).





Cabinet approves a 309 Km long new line project between Indore and Mumbai

- ❖ The project covers six districts in two states, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh. The project falls under the PM - Gati Shakti National Master Plan for multi-modal connectivity.
- ❖ The project will promote tourism in the region by providing a shorter route between the western and southwestern parts of the country and Central India.
