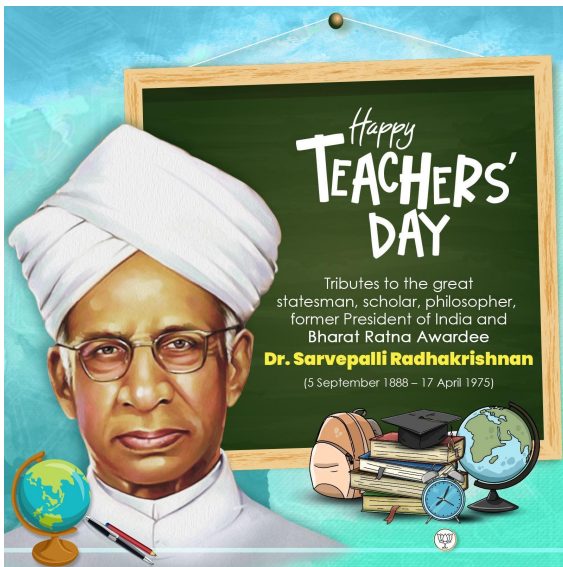

IMPORTANT DAYS

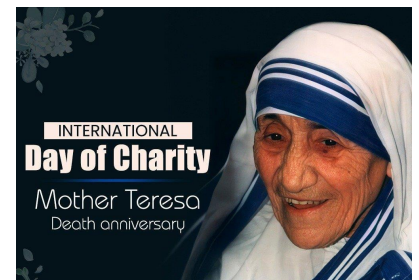
5th September - Teachers' Day (India)

- ❖ Marks the birth anniversary of **Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan**, a renowned scholar and philosopher, born on **September 5, 1888** in **Thiruttani**, present - day Tamil Nadu.
- ❖ First vice president of India from **1952 to 1962**. The second President of India from **1962 to 1967**.
- ❖ The **first Teachers' Day** was observed in **1962**.



5th Sept - International Day of Charity

- ❖ To commemorate the anniversary of the passing away of **Mother Teresa** of Calcutta, who received the **Nobel Peace Prize** in 1979.
- ❖ Mother Teresa died on **September 5th 1997**.

Punjab Assembly passes Bill to control spread of illegal colonies

- ❖ The **Punjab State Assembly** passed the **Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation (Amendment) Act, 2024**.
- ❖ Aims to overcome problems faced by the public in registration of their plots and check the development of **unauthorised colonies**.
- ❖ Its provisions state that if someone has brought plot from a coloniser before **July 31, 2024**, and has transferred advance payment, they can get their registry done without **No Objection certificate (NOC)** till **November 2nd**.

Himachal Pradesh Govt passes Bill under anti defection law

- ❖ The **Himachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly** (Allowances and Pension of Members) **Amendment Bill 2024** was introduced by Chief Minister **Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu**.
- ❖ Aims to deter and discourage MLAs from defecting parties by discontinuing their pension.
- ❖ According to the bill, “A person shall not be entitled to a pension under the Act if he has been disqualified at any point of time under the **tenth schedule** of the **Constitution (anti-defection law)**”.

Madhya Pradesh Government Unveils Brindavan Gram Scheme and Gita Bhavan Project

- ❖ The Madhya Pradesh government, under the leadership of Chief Minister **Mohan Yadav**, has approved a groundbreaking scheme named ‘**Brindavan Gram**’.
- ❖ This initiative aims to transform selected **gram panchayats** into model villages, focusing on **cow protection** and **rural development**.
- ❖ Each chosen village will establish a **gaushala (cow shed)** to promote cow welfare and protection. The scheme aims to increase rural milk production, boosting farmers' incomes. Roof-top solar policies will be implemented to promote clean energy in these villages.

- ❖ Wokha District Administration’s innovative initiative, **Wokha SAATHI** (Smart AI-based Assistant for Timely Help & Interface) **WhatsApp Chatbot**, has been awarded the prestigious “**Gold Award**” in the **National Awards for e-Governance Scheme 2023-2024** at the 27th National Conference on e-Governance held in Mumbai, Maharashtra.
- ❖ It is the **first time** an initiative from **Nagaland state** received a **Gold Award** for its exemplary contribution to e-Governance.
