


IMPORTANT DAYS


15th September - Engineer's Day

Celebrated in India to mark the birth anniversary of M Visvesvaraya, India's pioneering civil engineer. Declared by Government of India in 1968.

15th September - International Day of Democracy

- Established by the UN General Assembly in 2007, encouraging governments to strengthen and consolidate democracy. First observed in 2008.
- Theme is "Ensuring effective governance of AI at all levels".





16th September - World Ozone Day

- Theme is "Montreal Protocol: Advancing Climate Action".
- Commemorating the date, in 1987, on which the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer was signed.
- Proclaimed in 1994 by the United Nations General Assembly.

UPI Users can now Send 5 Lakh For Some Transactions

- The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI), which manages the UPI operations in the country, has decided to enhance the limit for tax payments through UPI from Rs. 1 lakh to Rs. 5 lakh per transaction.
- Last month, NPCI introduced the 'UPI Circle', a feature designed to enable primary UPI account holders to delegate payment responsibilities to secondary users securely.

India jumps to Tier 1 in Global Cyber security Index 2024

- Global Cyber security Index (GCI) 2024 released by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU).
- The 'GCI 2024' used a new five tier analysis, a shift that allows a greater focus on each country's advances with cyber security commitments.



The report placed 46 countries in Tier 1, the highest of the five tiers, reserved for "role modelling" countries that demonstrate a strong commitment in all five cyber security pillars.

Door darshan to complete 65 glorious years

- Established on 15th September 1959, Door darshan marked the beginning of India's broadcasting era. The then President, Rajendra Prasad inaugurated the first broadcast on that day.
- Door darshan remains India's largest broadcasting entity. Door darshan has grown into a network operating 35 satellite channels.
- In addition to these stations, Door darshan operates the DD DTH service "DD Free Dish" from the Earth Station, Todapur, Delhi.

- It is an indigenously designed and developed Light Tank, expected to be inducted into the Indian Army by the year 2027.
- The 25 tonne Zorawar tank, developed by DRDO's Combat Vehicles Research & Development Establishment (CVRDE) in collaboration with Larsen & Toubro Ltd (L&T).
