#### Manu Bhaker Appointed Brand Ambassador for Ports Ministry



# Union Finance Minister Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman to launch NPS Vatsalya Scheme on September 18, 2024

NPS Vatsalya was announced in the Budget 2024-25. The Scheme will be run under the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA).




- NPS Vatsalya is an extension of the already existing National Pension Scheme to children.
- It enables parents of children under 18 to open pension accounts for their minor children. Upon turning 18 years old, the NPS Vatsalya account will automatically get converted to regular NPS account.
- Permanent Retirement Account Number (PRAN) cards will be issued to newly registered minor subscribers.
- ★ The minimum contribution to open the Vatsalya account is ₹1,000. Subscribers will have to contribute ₹1,000 annually thereafter.

#### Cabinet nod to Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan

- ◆ It aimed at upliftment of **tribal communities** with an outlay of **Rs. 79,156 crore**.
- ✤ It will cover all tribal majority villages across 30 States / UTs, benefitting more than 5 crore tribal people as announced in the Budget Speech 2024-25.

Further, the scheme comprises of 25 interventions which will be implemented by 17 - line ministries, in a time bound manner in next 5 years to achieve goals including:

- Building pucca house with availability of tapped water (Jal Jeevan Mission) and electricity supply (RDSS).
- Eligible ST household will also have access to Ayushman Bharat Card (PMJAY).
- All weather road connectivity to ST majority villages (PMGSY).
- Provide access to mobile connectivity (Bharat Net) and internet.
