#### 26th September - World Environmental Health Day

- ❖ Declared by the Council of the International Federation of Environmental Health (IFEH) in 2011.

- ❖ The UN General Assembly declared the Day. Observed annually since
- ❖ Achieving global nuclear disarmament is the highest disarmament priority of the United Nations.
- ❖ It was the subject of the General Assembly's first resolution in 1946.


#### ADB funds Rs. 530 Crore for Tripura's Water Supply Upgrade

- ❖ Tripura Chief Minister Manik Saha launched the 'Mukhyamantri Nagar Unnayan Prakalp' a Rs. 530 crore water supply project funded by the Asian Development Bank (ADB). Completion be within three years.
- ❖ A major drinking water problem of over **75,000 families** in **12 cities** in the state would be resolved.

PM Modi addressed the 'Summit of the Future' at the 79<sup>th</sup> United Nations General Assembly in New York

- **❖** Theme of the 2 day Summit is 'Multilateral Solutions for a Better Tomorrow'.
- ❖ PM Modi flagged "cyber, maritime and space" emerging as "new theatres of conflict", apart from terrorism.
- ❖ He pitched for "global digital governance" to ensure that national sovereignty and integrity are upheld.
- ❖ World leaders at the 193 member UNGA adopted the Pact for the Future by consensus, a landmark declaration pledging concrete actions towards a safer, more peaceful, sustainable and inclusive world for tomorrow's generations.
- ❖ The Pact's five broad focus areas include: sustainable development, international peace and security, science and technology, youth and future generations and transforming global governance.

#### EAM Dr. S Jaishankar to address UNGA General Debate on 28th September




- ❖ The UNGA 79, held from 10<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2024 focuses on accelerating progress toward achieving the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- ❖ The 79<sup>th</sup> session is being chaired by Cameroonian President Philemon Yong.
- ❖ Dr. S Jaishankar will represent India in the General Debate and will deliver a speech on the 28<sup>th</sup> of September.
- ❖ The theme for the general debate is "Leaving No One Behind: Acting Together for the Advancement of Peace, Sustainable Development and human dignity for Present and future generations".

# India surpasses Japan to become 3<sup>rd</sup> largest power in Asia power index

- ❖ The Index was launched by the Lowy Institute in 2018. It evaluates 27 countries across the Asia Pacific region.
- ❖ The index uses eight core measures such as Economic Capability, Military Capability and Diplomatic Influence.
- ❖ The Sydney based Lowy Institute has put the U.S. at the top of its Asia Power Index with a score of 81.7, followed by China with a score of 72.7, India (39.1) and Japan (38.9), Australia (31.9) and Russia (31.1).

- ❖ IGIA has improved its position to the 24<sup>th</sup> spot from last year's 25<sup>th</sup>.
- ❖ The only other Indian airport among the top 50 megahub airports such as Mumbai's Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport (CSMIA) however dropped 10 spots from last year to the 44<sup>th</sup> position.

#### DRDO & IIT Delhi develop ABHED Light Weight Bullet Proof Jackets

- ❖ Named **ABHED** (Advanced Ballistics for High Energy Defeat). The jackets have been developed at the DRDO Industry Academia Centre of Excellence (DIA CoE) at IIT, Delhi.
- ❖ These jackets have been created from polymers and indigenous boron carbide ceramic material.
- ❖ With minimum possible weight of **8.2 kgs** and **9.5 kgs** for different BIS Levels, these modular design jackets having front & rear armours provide **360° protection**.
